## Programs for High School Students

The Challenger Dual Enrollment Program provides currently enrolled high school students with the opportunity to enrich their education through college courses at CCM. The **Titans Express Dual Enrollment Program** enables students to receive college credits by taking CCM courses at their high school while still enrolled in high school.

The Academy Program, Share Time Programs, and Early College Programs, through Morris County Vocational and Technical School, offers a number of programs by which students enroll in classes at the high school and on the CCM campus.

College Promise Programs offer motivated low-income middle and high school students from designated Morris County school districts the opportunity to secure a college path by helping students and their families address the academic and financial challenges of furthering a post-secondary education.
