

International Students

CCM has currently suspended all F1, B1 and B2 international student admissions. This only applies to F1, B1 and B2 students. All other eligible nonimmigrant visa holders such as E,J,H, L who are authorized to stay in the US for a limited period of time with a specific purpose may apply for admission.

Non-immigrant visa holders may attend the college on a full or part-time basis depending on their visa classification.

Applications must include the \$30 application fee, Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) scores or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam scores (if applying from their home country), the name and address of a New Jersey contact, and their original secondary school transcripts. If documents are not from an English-speaking country, transcripts must be translated to English and notarized by an official translating agency. Personal translations will not be accepted. Transfer credits earned in institutions of higher learning from foreign countries must be evaluated by a nationally accredited agency such as World Education Services, Inc. or SpanTran: The Evaluation Company, for consideration of advance standing. International applicants are required to submit a completed International Student Application for Admission, the application fee, an original secondary school transcript, TOEFL or IELTS scores and transcripts by June 1 for the Fall Semester and October 1 for the Spring Semester.

The minimum score accepted on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Internet-based test is 32. The minimum score on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam is 5.

Note: different visa statuses are entitled to different tuition rates. Individuals should consult with the Office of Admissions to confirm the tuition rate established for their visa status.
