Courses

ENV-108. Introduction to Sustainability Lecture. 3 Credits. LECT 45 hrs

This course introduces the topic of global sustainability through an interdisciplinary lens. Students will gain an understanding of environmental, economic, social, and other global concerns relating to sustainability. Strategies for the successful implementation of socially equitable, sustainable practices will be discussed. This course has been designed to prepare students for national and international certification exams related to sustainability. This course may or may not be taken with Introduction to Sustainability Laboratory (ENV-109).

ENV-109. Introduction to Sustainability Laborator. 1 Credit. LAB 30 hrs

This course provides hands-on experience through the completion of laboratory exercises and assessments that relate to the three pillars of sustainability (environmental, economic, and social). Students will use a combination of social and scientific research to develop informed, equitable, sustainable solutions to environmental issues. This course includes field trips that may require moderate physical activity. This course may or may not be taken with Introduction to Sustainability Lecture (ENV-108).
